Exciting milestones reached across Hornsey Town Hall site

Welcome to the Autumn 2020 edition of the Hornsey Town Hall Community Newsletter, giving you an insight into what's happening on and around the site. We thank residents for their understanding as the work to transform and carefully restore Hornsey Town Hall continues, alongside other construction works elsewhere in the local area.



CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW UREN AND AYRES BUILDINGS

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Construction on the new Uren and Ayres residential buildings is progressing well, with completions expected from August 2021.

The reinforced concrete frame to the north core of Block A (Uren) has recently been completed and there will be weekly concrete pours to the south core of the block throughout November. Works are also advancing well on Block B (Ayres) and across the remainder of the site.

Elsewhere across the development, Ardmore continues with restoration work on the Town Hall. Their current focus is on improving areas of roof on the Town Hall and theatre with replacement slating. Meanwhile, the first-floor corridor to the east is due to be demolished, as is the west wing restaurant area. Preparations are also being made for extensions to the east wing.

In addition, as part of FEC's exciting plans for a new hotel at Hornsey Town Hall, construction of the first mock up bedrooms for this space are shortly due to commence.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

In September, Ardmore was pleased to host a virtual 'Meet the Builder' event for neighbouring residents, at which a presentation on the company's history and involvement in the project was given. There are plans for similar events in future, for which details will be provided in due course.

Our Construction Steering Group meetings also continue to take place regularly, which are an opportunity for the Hornsey Town Hall team to provide updates on the project and to listen to issues important to residents.
